SMALL GROUP APPLICATION QUESTIONS

Don't miss the limited opportunity to invest for your future in eternity.

1. REVIEW THE SERMON

Read Matthew 6:19-21. What is Jesus' teaching on wealth in this passage and how does it address those who worship money and those who reject it? What connection does Jesus make between behaviors and the heart in the passage?

Read Matthew 6:22-24. What do our eyes have to do with our wealth and money? Why does Jesus use the analogy of slavery in verse 24 and how does this help you more clearly assess your heart in the area of wealth and money?

2. ASSESS YOUR LIFE

Think about everything you have acquired/own. Is there anything that is solely for your worldly benefit that is not making a spiritual impact? What can you do to invest it or its worth in a spiritual treasure instead?



What feeds critical comparison in your life (ex. TV Ads, Social Media, etc...)?

What can you do to minimize or remove this negative input? How does comparing yourself and your life to others impact your heart towards others and God?

3. APPLY THE TRUTH

Do you struggle with money being a competing master in your life? What evidence do you see for your response? How have you tried to divide your devotion between God and other things?

4. COMMIT THIS WEEK

Jesus emphatically commands us to stop worshipping money and possessions over Him. What do you need to do this week to start aligning your life with His command?
