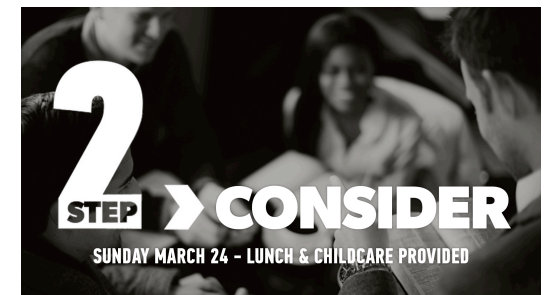

SMALL GROUP APPLICATION QUESTIONS

You do not have, because you do not ask. You ask and do not receive, because you ask wrongly, to spend it on your passions. — James 4:2b-3

1. REVIEW THE SERMON

2. ASSESS YOUR LIFE

Do you feel like your prayers are currently being hindered or have you felt this way in the past? What things on the list Pastor Micah gave could be hindering your prayers now or did in the past? Share an example with the group.

3. APPLY THE TRUTH

How does your view of God need to change so that your prayer life can be all Jesus wants it to be? What can you do moving forward to better relate to God as a loving Father who is eager to give good gifts to those who ask?

What have you been failing to seek or ask God for lately? What new thing will you ask Him for this week?
