SMALL GROUP APPLICATION QUESTIONS

If the Gospel hasn't changed you, then the Gospel hasn't saved you.

1. REVIEW THE SERMON

Read Matthew 7:21-23. Why does Jesus turn certain people away from entering heaven in this passage? What are some modern day examples of these false assurances?

Read Matthew 7:24-29. What do the rock and the sand represent in this story? What determines which one you are building upon? How do verses 21-29 impact your understanding of salvation by grace through faith?

2. ASSESS YOUR LIFE

When you get to judgment day and stand before Jesus, how will He respond to you? How do you know? What evidence can you point to in your life to support your answer?



Are you building your life on the rock or the sand? How do you know? What evidence can you give to support your answer?

3. APPLY THE TRUTH

The storms of life often reveal the reality of our faith. What recent storms have you encountered and what did they reveal to you about your faith and its foundation? What areas of your life are built on a foundation other than Jesus, the rock?

4. COMMIT THIS WEEK

What step will you take this week to build more of your life on the solid foundation of Jesus, the rock?

Look back through the whole Sermon on the Mount. What area of your life is Jesus calling you to more faithfully follow Him right now?
