SMALL GROUP APPLICATION QUESTIONS

What I believe about God impacts every part of my life – including my marriage.

1. REVIEW THE SERMON

Read Jeremiah 9:23-24. What does the prophet say is most important in life? What three ways did Pastor Micah highlight that God helps us in this pursuit? How does all of this apply to our marriages and/or relationships?

Read 1 Timothy 1:15-16 and Psalm 51:4. Why does Paul call himself the foremost sinner? How should the fact that all sin is against God change our view of sin? How does my view of my sin impact my marriage and/or relationships?

Read Galatians 5:17 and Ephesians 5. What is the true source of conflict in my life and relationships? How does this impact my ability to love others including my spouse? What is the primary purpose of marriage and how does this relate to my view of God?



2. ASSESS YOUR LIFE

How do you normally assess and respond to conflict in your marriage or relationships? What does this reveal about your view of God, yourself and sin?

3. APPLY THE TRUTH

What are ways you have made marriage or your relationships about you? What do you need to do to correct this in light of God's Word? Where do you need to repent of your own sin in order to better follow God's Word for your marriage or relationships?

4. COMMIT THIS WEEK

The Bible, the Gospel and the Glory of God are key to God-honoring marriages and relationships. How will you use them this week to get a better view of God for your life, marriage and relationships?
