Paul was writing this letter to the Romans in part to provide clarity on the truths of the Gospel and dispel mis-understandings that were creating divisions in the church. How has your understanding of the Gospel changed as you have matured as a believer? Are there any parts of the Gospel that are less clear to you today — or more challenging for you to accept?
