1. STUDY THE SCRIPTURE

Read Prov. 4:23, Is. 26:3, Pr. 14:30 and Romans 12:2. How do these verses relate to Paul's message in the Ephesians passage?

2. ASSESS YOUR LIFE

Paul says "Gentiles" or unbelievers walk in the futility of their minds. What does he mean by this and what are some examples of how you did this before you came to Christ? He also tells us "to put off our old self". How does this relate to our minds before and after we started following Christ? What parts of your old self have you put off and which ones do you still struggle to put off?
