SMALL GROUP APPLICATION QUESTIONS

1. STUDY THE WORD

Read Deuteronomy 5:16 and Ephesians 6:1-3. Why is the context to each of these passages significant? How does it help us better understand and apply this command?

2. ASSESS YOUR LIFE

Read Romans 1:29-31 and 2 Timothy 3:2-4. Why do you think God included “disobedient to parents” in these lists? How do these verses impact your understanding of the command to honor your parents? Is it hard or easy for you to honor your parents? Why?

Pastor Micah gave a definition for obedience. How does this definition line up with how obedience was taught in your home growing up, or the way it is taught in your house now if you have children?
