

Jesus and the early church followed a specific pattern for selecting spiritual leaders – time, testing and testimony from the Spirit through other spiritual leaders. (Acts 1:24, 6:6, 13:2-3, 14:23, 1 Tim 4:14, 2 Tim 1:6) How is this similar and different than how leaders are often selected in our culture? Why do you think God chose this process over others? How do you see this process in practice at Harvest?

Do you sometimes question your status on Jesus's team because of how you are different than others? If so, how and why? How does comparison hurt Jesus's team and hinder His mission?
