Jesus's response to the situation in this passage is unlike any other we have seen from Him so far. Why do you think Jesus responded this way? What does His response teach us about Him? What does His response teach us about ourselves and faith?
Everyone is in awe of the miracle, so Jesus decides this is the right moment to drop some bad news on them. Why do you think the disciples didn't understand Jesus's saying, and were afraid to ask Him? Why do you think Jesus chose this moment to reiterate His coming passion? How does the Gospel assure me that I am delivered, and how can this help you live out your identity as one delivered from sin in your daily life.

What do you need to be delivered from today in your heart or life? Ask Jesus in faith and let Him deliver you.
