Verses 21-22 turn from the disciples' rejoicing to Jesus's rejoicing. How is Jesus's rejoicing categorically different than the disciples? Many people in the world today think God is mean and vengeful if He punishes people for unrepentant sin. How can you defend Jesus's statement that God revealing Himself to only some people (little children) but not all, is "gracious"? When did you receive the revelation of Jesus and the gift of faith? How did this change your view of God and your own salvation?
