SMALL GROUP APPLICATION QUESTIONS

If I am not living and sharing what I have received from Jesus, I have missed my calling.

1. REVIEW THE SERMON

Read Matthew 5:13-16. Why does Jesus call His disciples “the salt of the earth”? What does it mean for followers of Christ to be salty? How and why do disciples sometimes lose their saltiness?

Why does Jesus call His disciples “the light of the world”? How does this relate to Jesus’ statement about Himself in John 8:12? What does it look like for His disciples to be light and what are some ways we fail to do this?

2. ASSESS YOUR LIFE

How salty are you? What are some examples/areas in your life where you do well at living like Jesus? What are some examples/areas where your living for Jesus gets diluted by things of the world? Why are these areas a struggle for you?



Who can see you reflecting the light of Jesus? In what areas of your life does your light shine bright and in what areas do you sometimes cover it up? Why do you cover it up those areas?

3. APPLY THE TRUTH

If we are not careful, pursuing holiness and living it out before others can lead us to the sins of self-dependency and pride. As you seek to be salt and light for Jesus, what can you do to make sure you are bringing glory to Him and not to yourself?

4. COMMIT THIS WEEK

What is 1 thing you can do to guard against the world diluting your life for Jesus?
What is 1 thing you can do to better shine your light into the darkness of this world?
